


Math Story Problem

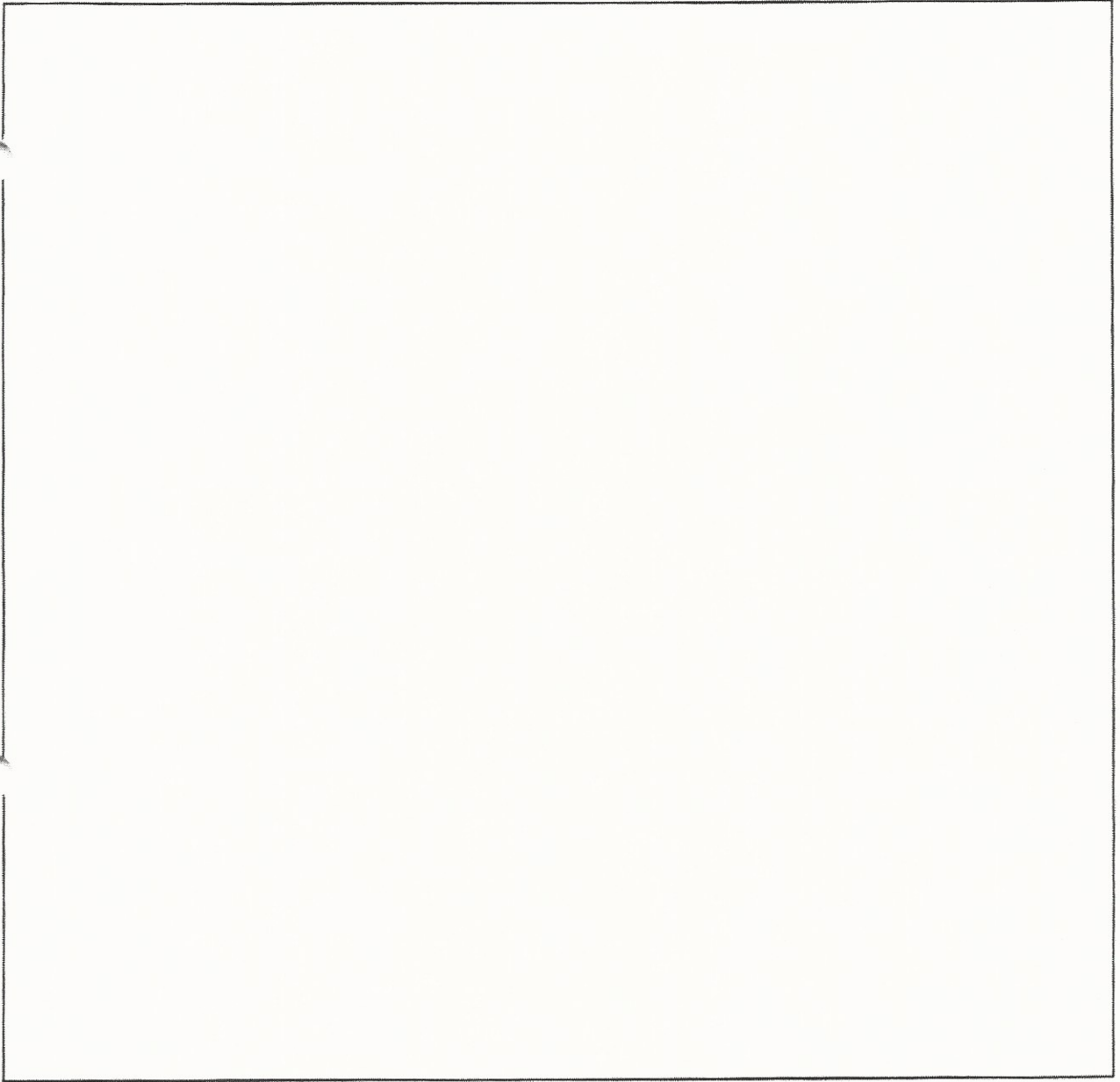
Isaiah had 22 marbles. He gave 14 marbles to Quasir. How many marbles does Isaiah have now?

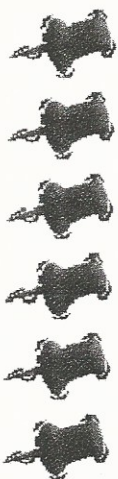
